

BULLYING, INTIMIDATION AND HARASSMENT

Bullying, intimidation or harassment at school on school grounds, in school vehicles, at designated school bus stops, at school-sponsored activities, or at school-sanctioned events are prohibited. School employees are responsible for supervision and monitoring of students activities and shall not tolerate any student hurting another student, either physically or psychologically.

Students are responsible for respecting the rights of their classmates and themselves. Students may tell the person doing the bullying, intimidation or harassment that what they are doing is unacceptable and that if it continues, they will report it. When students report misbehavior the school employee will take the appropriate corrective and disciplinary action.

The principal shall establish a Safe School Committee in compliance with state law and district policy. The Safe School Committee shall study and make recommendations to the principal regarding unsafe conditions and possible strategies for students and staff to avoid harm at school, student victimization, school violence, crime prevention, and other issues which prohibit the maintenance of a safe school.
