

Behavior Expectations - (Jim Faye "Love and Logic")

- 1. Feel free to do anything that does not cause a problem for anyone else.*
- 2. If student causes a problem, I will ask them to fix it.*
- 3. If they can't or will not fix it, I will do something.*
- 4. What I do will depend on what happened and what the person is willing to do to solve the problem.*
- 5. I teach when there are no distractions or other problems.*
- 6. I listen to one person at a time.*

INFRACTIONS

Level 1

1ST infraction = verbal warning (offer student a chance to correct behavior)

2nd infraction = character first writing

3rd infraction = miss recess

4th infraction = refer to counselor (parent called)

Level 2

5th infraction = parent called

6th infraction = refer to principal

7th infraction = parent/teacher/principal conference (behavior contract signed)

Level 3

8th infraction = parent shadowing required (before student is admitted back to class)

9th infraction = recovery room (with assignments)

10th infraction = possible suspension (principal's discretion)

Severe Clause

Students with weapons, drugs, threats, etc. will be removed immediately.

Fighting - Fighting is not acceptable. (Fighting is assault and battery. Our goal is to help children work through their problems rather than fight.) Fighting automatically brings in the Severe Clause in our Discipline Plan.

1st Fight - Serious Warning/Parent Notification - Parent and student come up with written plan.

2nd Fight - Mandatory Parent Conference - Short-Term suspension.

Examples of Reasons for Write-Up

1. No homework.

2. Inappropriate behavior in hall, bathroom, cafeteria, playground seen by any teacher.
3. Defiance with adult.
4. Excessive Talking in the classroom.
5. Disruptive Behavior.
6. Out of Uniform.
